Taste and Wait

11th week in the series 'Between the Times.'

2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

You can have it all. Or can you? Life is short. Or is it? The day of the Lord, says the apostle Paul, has not yet come. What therefore can and should we expect from this day?

Discussion Questions:

1. How do you respond to the adage "You can have it all"?
2. How do you respond to the adage "Life is short"?
3. What sort of effect to do you think the ethos represented in such adages?
4. If you are a believer in Jesus Christ, then the Holy Spirit has been given to you as a guarantee, or down payment, of your eternal inheritance and you can, in the words of the writer of Hebrews, taste "the powers of the age to come." How do you think you have tasted, or how do you think you might taste, such powers?
5. How do you think tasting the powers of the age to come may help us to live in the present while anticipating the feast to come?
