1 Samuel 25:1-44

After seeing David at his best in the previous story, we see a new side of David. Shaken by the death of Samuel, he is sent into a murderous rage by an insult. A wise woman steps up to help him avoid the mistake he is about to make. His response to her is as amazing as his angry rage. We'll see in ourselves the tendency to do the very things that we despise in others. And we'll be inspired to learn from the voices of others who can speak God's truth to us.
