The View from the Top

25th week in the series "A Life of Passion: The Story of David."

2 Samuel 7:1-29

What do you do with a dream? What does God do with it? David had a dream, and God did something with it. Did he ever! The hope for a Messiah takes shape in 2 Samuel 7. From this theological mountain, of 2 Samuel 7 you can see the entire biblical story, both past and future. This is breathtaking.

Discussion Questions:

1. What sort of dreams have you had, or do you have, for yourself? How have they come true and/or not come true?
2. If you are a believer in Christ, how would you describe your feelings about what God has done for you, delivering you from "the domain of darkness" and transferring you to "the kingdom of his beloved Son"? (Colossians 1:13)?
3. How do you respond to Paul's words that God is "able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think"? (Ephesians 3:20)
4. How do you personally connect with David's words in 2 Samuel 7:18: "Who am I, O Lord God, and what is my house, that you have brought me thus far?"
5. If you are a believer in Christ, how would you describe your feelings about "the hope of the glory of God"—that is, the hope for the day when we will reign with Christ in the new creation? (Romans 5:2)?
