What Kind of Kingdom?

Palm Sunday

Mark 11:1-11

As we begin Holy Week, the re-enactment of Jesus' last week on earth, we remember the entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. Mark's gospel records the crowd celebrating the "coming kingdom of our father David." We've spent a lot of time thinking about David as king, but what kind of a kingdom does he rule over? As we consider this scene in Jerusalem, we'll think about the kinds of kingdoms that we're a part of, the kind of kingdom we wish for, and the kind of kingdom that Jesus is actually establishing in the world.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What kind of kingdoms are you a part of? Social, professional, family, local, political, academic? What characterizes each of those kingdoms?
- 2. What kind of kingdoms do you wish for? What about your current life do you want to be different? What do you want out of life?
- 3. How do you understand the kingdom that Jesus is establishing on earth? What is surprising about it to you?
- 4. How can you live more fully aware that you are part of the kingdom of God in your daily life?
