2 Samuel 24:1-25

In 2 Samuel 24, we see David at his worst--and at his best. As such, the chapter represents a microcosm of his life. The chapter helps us when we are at our worst--and shows us how, even at our worst, we can be at our best. What did David know? And what does he have to teach us?

Discussion Questions:

- 5. How do you think God's acceptance of you can help you confront yourself?
