Journey of Hope

28th week in the series *Sent: Living the Mission of the Church*

Luke reports that when “the days drew near” for Jesus, he “set his face to go to Jerusalem.” For all of us, of course, the days are drawing near: we’re one day closer to the end than we were yesterday. If the days are drawing near, how should we live?

Discussion Questions:

1. How do you think you might go about “setting your face” toward the new Jerusalem?
2. How do you think doing so might influence the way you live until you arrive in the new Jerusalem?
3. Romans 8:28: “And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.” Considering that God’s good purpose is the final glorification of his people, how does this verse impact you?
4. Romans 8:1: “There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.” How does this verse impact you?
5. Psalm 73:28: “But for me, the nearness of God is my good.” How have you found—or not found—the nearness of God to be your good?
