That's Not Fair!

Sixth week in the series: *Knowing the God of Justice and Hope*

Ezekiel 18

The Israelites, suffering in exile, believed that they were suffering for the sins of their fathers and that the Lord hadn't treated them fairly. If we are inclined to think that the Lord hasn't treated us fairly, listening for how he responds to the exiles will serve us well.

Discussion Questions:

1. How do you feel you may have been a victim of wrongdoing (insofar as you're able to share it with others, assuming that you're in a discussion group)?
2. How do you think it has affected you?
3. How do you think you may need to "repent and 'turn"—especially from the tendency to blame others or God for your problems or for you sin?
4. How do you think that "looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith," can help us in the repentance process?
