13th week in the series: *Knowing the God of Justice and Hope*

Ezekiel 43:1-11

5. How do you think you might go about putting off "your old self" and putting on "the new self," which is "created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness" (Ephesians 2:22-24)?
