# Thirsty

27th week in the series: *Wake Up*

Revelation 22:6-21

In the epilogue to the book of Revelation, the author, John, conveys to us the essence of what he wants us to get from his composition. In fact, we read in the final chapter the most important sentence in the book. The sentence only takes two words.

## Discussion Questions:

1. The most important sentence in the book of Revelation is this: “Worship God.” What do you think it means practically for you to worship God? How do you or could you go about worshipping God?
2. John says, “And let the one who is thirsty come [to Jesus].” What are you “thirsty” for?
3. What do you think it might look like for you to come to Jesus with the thirst in your soul?
4. We hear repeatedly in Revelation 22:6-21 that Jesus is coming—now, in an ongoing sense, and finally, in a permanent sense. Put into words what this promise means to you.
