C. The Oath for Compassionate Service from *Toxic Charity* by Robert Lupton

- 1. Never do for the poor what they have (or could have) the capacity to do for themselves.
- 2. Limit one-way giving to emergency situations.
- 3. Strive to empower the poor through employment, lending, and investing, using grants sparingly to reinforce achievements.
- 4. Subordinate self-interests to the needs of those being served.
- 5. Listen closely to those you seek to help, especially to what is not being said—unspoken feelings may contain essential clues to effective service.
- 6. Above all, do no harm.

D. Practical Suggestions

- 1. Remember that you're not giving to get glory for yourself but for God.
- 2. The larger the gift, the more you should investigate its effectiveness.
- 3. If you don't have the time or ability to investigate, give to an organization that does.
- 4. Responding to beggars
 - a. Be safe. Bring someone with you or stay in public, well lighted places.
 - b. Approach people calmly and cautiously. Don't rush them.
 - c. Look people in the eye, get down on their level, treat them like people.
 - Even when you have to say no.
 - d. Ask the person his name and pray for him.
 - e. Buy a meal for her. Eat with her if you can.
 - f. Have gift cards in your wallet ready to give (McDonald's, Starbucks, etc.).
 - g. Make homeless care kits to keep in your car https://foodlets.com/2017/12/15/what-to-put-in-care-packages-for-thehomeless/
 - h. Don't force people to accept your gift.
